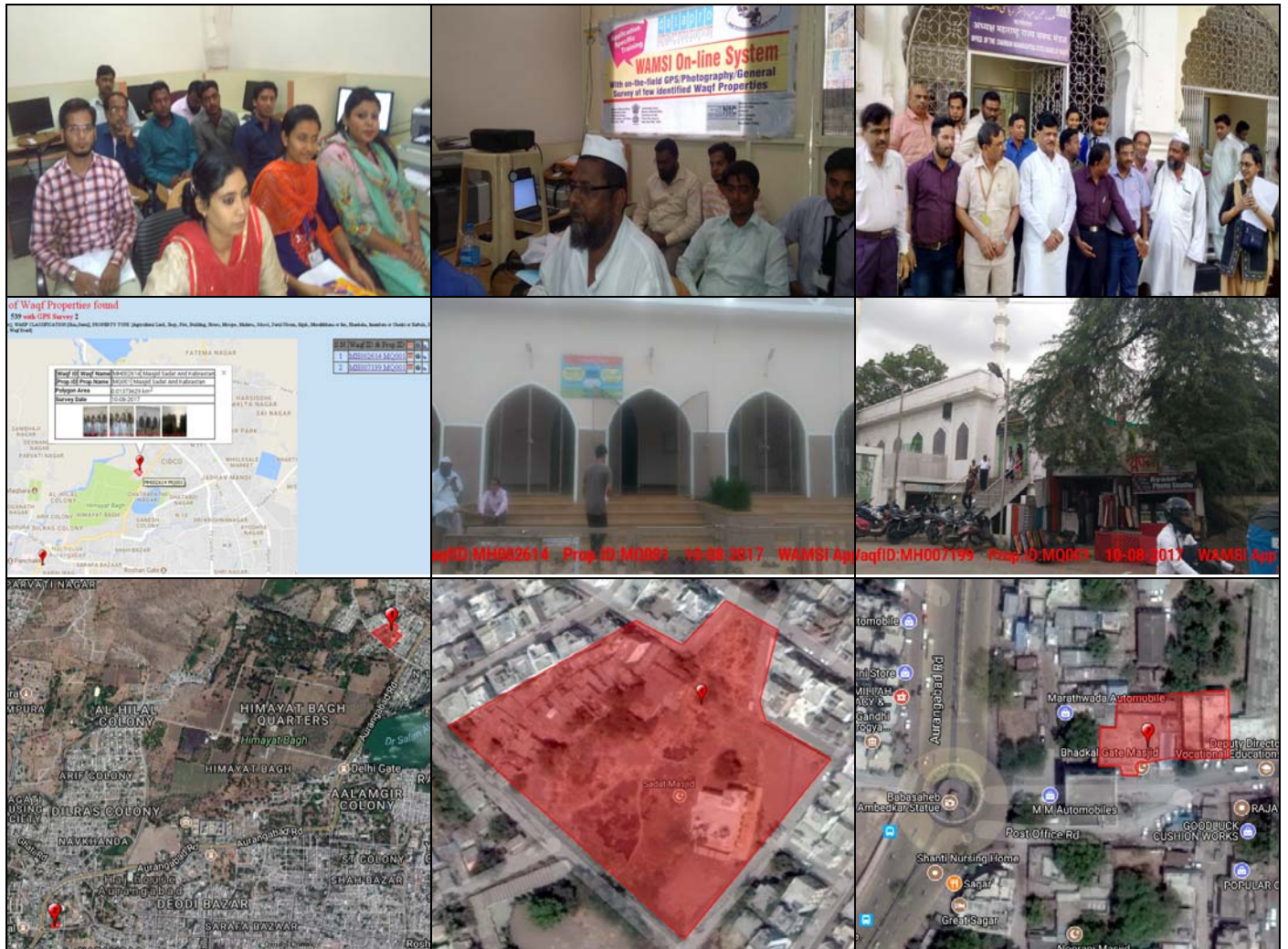

## Joint Training Programme of staff of Maharashtra State and Dadra & Nagar Haveli UT Waqf Boards held at Aurangabad (Maharashtra State) on WAMSI On-line System

The 20<sup>th</sup> Joint Training Programme in the series was conducted for the staff of Maharashtra State and Dadra & Nagar Haveli UT Waqf Boards at Aurangabad (Maharashtra State) on all the Modules of WAMSI On-line System from August 07 to 11, 2017 by M/s. Datapro Computer Pvt. Ltd., (an empanelled agency of NICSI) at Centralized Computing Facility (CCF) of Maharashtra State Waqf Board, Panchakki, AURANGABAD - 431002.

After brief introduction by the Trainer, the Training Programme was formally inaugurated by Hon'ble Chairperson Shri Mahemud Maheeb Shaikh of Maharashtra State Waqf Board in presence of staff members of both Maharashtra State and Dadra & Nagar Haveli UT Waqf Boards. More than Ten Staff Members have attended the Training Programme as more staff members have come than allocated from Dadra & Nagar Haveli UT Waqf Board to learn WAMSI operations. This shows how keen they are to use WAMSI for the management of their Waqf Properties. In order to ensure proper training for the staff Shri Naeem Ahmed, Director (Technical) & National WAMSI Project Coordinator from National Informatics Centre (HQ), New Delhi have also participated in the training programme and transferred the knowledge to the participants by conducting GPS Surveys on actual Waqf Properties with emphasis on best practices. All the Staff members took active interest in the whole Training Programme. All the Modules of WAMSI On-line System were taken-up for data entry demonstration as well as practice by the participants. Doubts were cleared during the detailed & live demonstration of data entered by the participants. Waqf Properties identified by WAMSI IDs (MH002614MQ001 and MH007199MQ001) were GPS surveyed. WAMSI in-built GIS found that major encroachments took place on the peripheral vacant areas of both the Waqf Properties over a period of time as seen in the GIS snapshots given below. This is a proof of concept for a GIS Decision Support System.

Purpose of computerization was also made clear to them and consequently, they all appreciated the efforts of Government of India in the protection of the Waqf Properties and inculcating the Transparency in the working of State/UT Waqf Boards.
