### About this Waqf Estate:

Makhdoom-ul-Alam Hazrat Alauddin Ali Ahmed Kaliyari, also known as Sabir Kaliyari ("Patient Saint of Kaliyar"), was a prominent South Asian Sufi saint in the 13th century, nephew and khalifa (successor) to Baba Fareed (1188–1280), and the first in the Sabiriya branch of the Chishti Order. Equally revered by Hindus and Muslims in South Asia. The story of his title being as Sabir is as follows:

His mother gave custody of Alauddin to her brother Baba Fareed and asked him to take care of the boy, whom he later made his disciple. Baba Fareed put him in charge of the Langar (a shared kitchen). After a long time, Alauddin's mother came to see him and found him very weak. She was angry at her brother and demanded an explanation. Baba Fareed explained that he had been set in charge of the kitchen and hence should have had no shortage of food. When Alauddin was asked, he replied, "True, I was put in charge of the kitchen, but I was never told I could eat from it." When asked how he managed to remain alive, he revealed that he went to the jungle during his free time and ate whatever he found there. He was then given the name Sabir (Patient One).

He achieved the position of Kaliyar Sharif in AD 1253, after being anointed as the protector of Kaliyar village by Baba Fareed. He stayed there for the rest of his life and died here on 13 Rabi' al-awwal, 690 Hijri (1291). He had only one disciple, and a branch of the Chisti Order, called Chisti Sabiri, was initiated through that disciple.

## News & Views from MoMA



Union Minister for Minority Affairs, Shri K. Rehman Khan took the Review Meeting of GoI Scheme of Computerization of Records of State Waqf Boards on June 25, 2013 at New Delhi where most of the Chairpersons, Chief Executive Officers and SWB Nodal Officers of State Waqf Boards along with Senior Officers of Ministry and CWC were present. While reviewing the progress of data entry in WAMSI Modules as a part of implementation of Phase-I of the Scheme, he urged the State Waqf Boards to complete the data entry work at the earliest. A proactive approach is to be followed by every State Waqf Board by nominating an exclusive SWB Nodal Officer to supervise the work of WAMSI Project.



Deputy Director General Shri Sanjay S. Gahlout (NIC) has stressed upon the SWBs to evolve a mechanism to simultaneously verify the authenticity of data being entered in WAMSI Systems as the intention of the Government to publish Waqf Properties Information on Internet for the general public.
