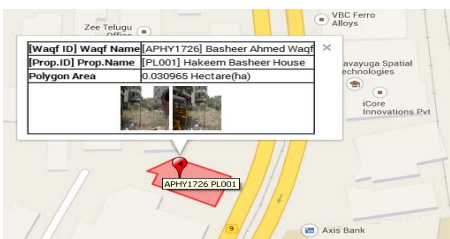
NPC visit to some Waqf Properties in Hyderabad.

British High Commissioner, Sir James Bevan met the Union Minister for Minority Affairs, Dr. Najma A. Heptulla, in New Delhi on June 16, 2014 and discussed various matters of mutual interest related to minorities.



67th Meeting of the Central Waqf Council.

The 67th Meeting of the Central Waqf Council (CWC) was held on June 24, 2014 under the Chairpersonship of Dr. Najma A. Heptulla, the Union Minister for Minority Affairs. The Minister is also the Chairperson of the CWC. The Council discussed important issues concerning the effective functioning of the State Waqf Boards in the country. The Council discussed issues in depth and took decisions for the better management of Auqaf. The Council decided that:

- * All the provisions of the Waqf (Amendment) Act, 2013 need to be implemented by the State Governments.
- * To carry out awareness campaign to sensitize waqf institutions.
- * Muttawalis to furnish Annual Report to the State Waqf Boards as per format designed by Central Waqf Council.
- * CWC members to visit State Waqf Board(s) of their respective state and report.
- * Council to encourage educational development of the community through technical institutions.



Dr. Najma A. Heptulla stressed on the Result Oriented Implementation of various Schemes of the Ministry.

Dr. Najma A. Heptulla, Union Minister of Minority Affairs has asked for result-oriented implementation of all schemes meant for minorities. She said that State Governments have to play active role to ensure that the schemes meant to improve the lives of Minorities reach the genuine beneficiaries. Dr. Najma Heptulla said this on June 27, 2014 in a meeting with Shri Antar Singh Arya, Minister of Labour, Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare, Denotified, Nomadic and Semi-nomadic Tribes Welfare, Government of Madhya Pradesh.

Shri Antar Singh Arya called on the Minister to discuss issues relating to Minorities in Madhya Pradesh. Elaborating on various schemes being implemented by the Ministry of Minorities Affairs (MoMA), Dr. Heptulla advocated that new ideas be woven into traditional crafts under skill development programmes to enhance marketability of the skills and products. Dr. Heptulla emphasized that preservation and promotion of traditional arts and crafts of the State should be given priority. The Minister emphasized on creating more awareness among all minorities about their rights. She also stressed on enhanced role of State Governments in maintenance and development of Waqf Properties.
