Dr.S.A.S. Naqvi has joined as Secretary, Central Waqf Council w.e.f. 08-March-2019



Dr. S.A.S. Naqvi, a renowned scientist in the field of Oceanography, Ministry of Earth Sciences, Government of India, has taken over the charge of Secretary, Central Waqf Council (CWC) w.e.f. March 08, 2019, who has evinced his keen interest in the Computerization Scheme and putting his effort to formulate a visionary plan to make the scheme result oriented with faster, timely and effective implementation. In this context Dr. Naqvi is taking regular meetings with the concerned officers of CWC to review the progress in all aspects of Computerization and trying to find out the obstructions, if any, in achieving smooth progress of the scheme.

He informed National WAMSI Project Team of NIC that he has chalked out certain agenda in this regard such as frequent Review Meetings at the State/UT Waqf Boards (SWBs) offices, conducting regular Video Conferencing with Staff engaged by the SWBs out of the funds provided under the scheme for immediate remedial action and troubleshooting of the issues involved, if any and regular field visits by the officers involved in the scheme implementation from CWC, Ministry and NIC, interaction with Waqf Institutions and their Mutawallis for their active involvement in the computerization process for protection of Waqf properties as well as to enhance their income as per the noble concept of Waqf . Dr. Naqvi is of the view that the important tool of any organization is based on personnel available and the quality of their level of intelligence. Therefore, he has desired to strengthen the internal structure of the CWC to fulfill its mandate. He further informed that he has already started developing and motivating the CWC staff for effective leadership quality for better results. He has sought the details of the short training programmes being conducted by various organizations for up gradation of the skill of the CWC staff at various levels.

It is pertinent to note that the Ministry of Minority Affairs, Government of India had launched the scheme entitled as “Computerization of Records of State/UT Waqf Boards” during the year 2009, which is subsequently renamed as “Qaumi Waqf Board Taraqqiati Scheme” (QWBTS) in the year 2017. The scheme was launched with an objective to streamline the records keeping and transparency in the functioning and to achieve automation of various activities of the SWBs with the prime objective of developing a single web based centralized up-to-date database system to manage the Waqf properties in India. Now, the Ministry has entrusted the responsibility of implementing the QWBTS scheme in all the SWBs to CWC. It is observed during last few years that the scheme is steadily progressing as per the laid down guidelines. However, in order to complete the remaining work of the scheme as per its timelines, CWC has to accelerate the monitoring in all respects in close consultation with SWBs, as their cooperation is vital in timely progressing under the overall guidance of the Ministry of Minority Affairs, Government of India.

He further informed that 20 SWBs have been provided with Video Conference facility for monitoring the scheme. Remaining SWBs will also be covered shortly. Review meetings are being conducted to review the progress of the implementation of the scheme however efforts are being made to have such meetings twice in a month to impress upon the SWBs for their active participation.
