Secretary, Central Waqf Council, joined



Shri B. M. Jamal has formally joined as **Secretary, Central Waqf Council (CWC)** on November 1, 2016.

Earlier, he was the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of Kerala State Waqf Board, Kochi before joining CWC. He worked as CEO for more than 15 Years there. His function as CEO includes legal and administrative expertise. His main duties were to adjudicate matters relating to recovery of Waqf Properties, eviction on encroachment that involves both quasi-judicial and administrative proceedings. The Joint Parliamentary Committee (JPC) on Waqfs appreciated his work in the year 2008 when JPC visited Kerala and hold discussions with Kerala State Waqf Board.

He has vast experience in handling the Waqf matters and therefore, he managed the Waqf Properties so well. Consequently, Waqf Properties are protected and have generated optimal revenue compared to other State Waqf Boards in India despite the fact that almost all the Waqf Properties are managed either by Mutawallis or Management Committees (i.e., Indirect Management). He raised the Annual Income of Kerala State Waqf Board from Rs.50 Lakhs to Rs.8 Crores per year. This is quite evident from the figures of Statuary 1% Contributions paid to CWC in the past.

As a part of Academic achievements, he did B.A.(Law), LL.B.; Certificate in Personal Computers & Software Applications and completed his LL.M degree course.

He was in legal profession as a lawyer since 1990 before joining Kerala State Waqf Board and worked as Legal Advisor for various organizations, such as:
