## A Skill Development Academy MANAS formed by MoMA



A national level skill development Academy “Maulana Azad National Academy for Skills” (MANAS) is being set up with its headquarters in Delhi. This was announced by **Dr. Najma A. Heptulla**, the Hon'ble Union Minister for Minority Affairs, while inaugurating the Annual Conference of State Channelising Agencies (SCAs) of National Minorities Development & Finance Corporation (NMDFC) on October 08, 2014 at New Delhi. Hon'ble Minister said ‘MANAS’ will serve as a Specialized Vehicle to Implement Skill Development and Up-gradation Programme for the minority communities, being undertaken by MoMA and various other Ministries, Departments and Organizations of Central/State Governments. She informed that this is an ambitious project focusing on for providing skills training / up-gradation in those sectors of economy in which there is shortage or demand is likely to emerge in future, so that they can find gainful employment / self employment opportunities.

NMDFC will ensure concessional credit flows to such people who have undergone skill training/up-gradation and want to either set up, or expand their own business for self-employment. In a way ‘MANAS’ is being treated as missing link in between demand for skills, and need for concessional credit, to boost, skill training/up-gradation, and employment/self-employment. The academy will network with various national and international agencies for certification, placement and funding for the program. An MoU was also signed between MANAS and National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) to establish an extensive All India Collaborative Network for the Academy.

## WAMSI On-line Reporting: Compliance & Contributions

An additional Report has been added this month for knowing the compliance of Annual Returns Filing and Contributions Paid in a particular Financial Year by the Managers of the Waqf Properties under various State/UT Waqf Boards starting with District, Sub-District and goes upto Towns/Villages. This additional reporting will help the CEOs of State/UT Waqf Boards to optimize their Revenue Collections and figure-out the Bottlenecks for remedial measures.

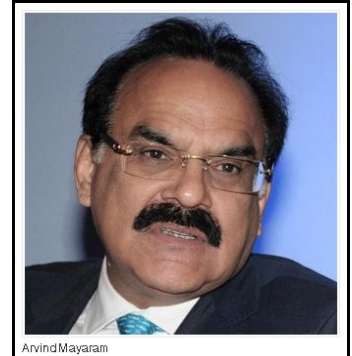
It has been observed from WAMSI On-line System Compliance & Contribution Report for Financial Year 2013-14, only 6 SWBs namely, Kerala (1 of 8613 assessable out of 36064 Immovable Waqf Properties), Lakshadweep (48 of 915 assessable out of 915 Immovable Waqf Properties), Madhya Pradesh (1 of 20085 assessable out of 20982 Immovable Waqf Properties), Maharashtra (2 of 18647 assessable out of 18647 Immovable Waqf Properties), Rajasthan (3 of 21552 assessable out of 23150 Immovable Waqf Properties), Tamil Nadu (1008 of 52982 assessable out of 53268 Immovable Waqf Properties), have entered the details of Annual Returns Filing in WAMSI On-line System and rest 22 SWBs where Waqf Properties registration data is available not bothered to entered their Annual Returns Filing information in WAMSI On-line System.

As per this Report, **Tamil Nadu SWB have complied the Return Filing** of 1.9% of the total Assessable Waqf Properties and aggregate Net Income shown is Rs. 34,10,57,300/- Managers of the Waqf Properties have also paid Rs.1,81,37,689/- (76%) out of prescribed Contribution of Rs. 2,38,62,983/- (Contribution to SWB for Administrative Expenses <= 7% as per The Waqf Act, 1995). **Kudos to Tamil Nadu SWB.**

This Report seems to be handy tool for the State/UT Waqf Boards to monitor the revenue in the current Financial Year too as the system is on-line and as soon as the data is entered, the same is reflected in the Report.

## Post-Sachchar Evaluation

The Post-Sachchar Evaluation Committee headed by **Prof. Amitabh Kundu** presented the final report to Dr. Najma A Heptulla, the Hon'ble Union Minister for Minorities Affairs on October 09, 2014 at New Delhi. Thanking Prof. Kundu and other members of the committee for their efforts, Hon'ble Minister promised to implement the recommendations after studying the Report as early as possible.

The Ministry of Minority Affairs, Government of India had constituted the Committee under the Chairmanship of **Prof. Amitabh Kundu of Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi and seven other eminent Social Scientists** in September, 2013. The mandate of the committee was to evaluate the process of implementation of Sachchar Committee Report and the Prime Minister's New 15 Points Programme.

The committee was also asked to assess the outcome of the programmes implemented by the Ministry of Minority Affairs and other Ministries in this respect and to recommend the corrective measures by September, 2014.

As per the mandate of the committee, it evaluated and assessed the implementation of the recommendations of the Sachchar Committee and made suggestions for obtaining better outcome in its Final Report submitted to the Minister of Minority Affairs.
